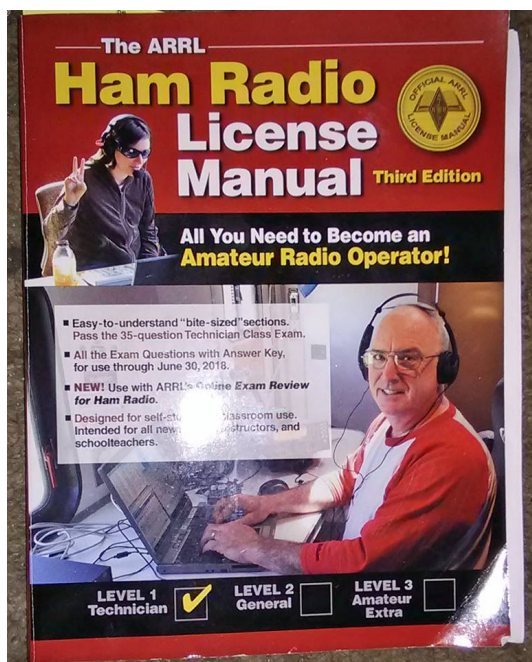

- 1) Participate in providing emergency communications in community events or actual emergencies. Call for help when phones are down.
- 2) Through certain repeaters or through satellites you can talk around the world.
- 3) Have fun with contests sponsored by the American Radio Relay League® or other groups.
- 4) Use it on camping trips or hiking. And much more.
